Even though it's nothing original, nothing awesome, speaking more yet some of these riffs sounds a bit ordinary, minimalistic like late CIANIDE for example. DIG ME NO GRAVE doesn't combine with very complex nor technical compositions. It's obviously straightforward death metal, in spite of it very well varied still. There are fast, sharp rhythms as well as many slowdowns or such throbbing, catchy riffs to complete a picture of their style. It's necessary to admit also that all these means are arranged and performed very compact way, exactly like it is with mature and well rooted bands! What to say more? Even though it's not timeless stuff, then I couldn't find any artifacts on the "Immemorial curse", moreover I've found it very pleasant and moving fragmentally album, so I can recommend it only for you all!

MYOPIA Transmyopic interconnection CD 2017

I don't like such music and it's a big pain for me personally when I must listen to something like that. 2. Of corpse you all know this group headed for Rogga Johansson, which then is one of the most active musicians on the death metal scene. I did review His HUMANITY DELETE somewhere before and now time has come for the 6th album made by THOSE WHO BRING TORTURE. And as for me it's one of many promo CD's I received from Mexican IRON, BLOOD AND DEATH CORPORATION, which is the label with many interesting releases. Well, let's play the "Pain offerings", which arrives with 9 songs, although the last one it's such instrumental, nostalgic outro rather. But the proper tracks shouldn't surprise any listeners at all. Naturally it's purest, classical death metal and we all shouldn't expect anything different from Mr. Rogga, right? The sound could be described like a resultant of old Sweden, combined with old Holland and England, so old European death school speaking generally! The songwriting is straight to the bone and pretty characteristic for our hero, I mean about THOSE WHO BRING TORTURE naturally. I mean it's such catchy, melodic riffing, performed in slower, throbbing and very rhythmical tempos most gladly. It's pretty atmospheric death metal so, however I don't mean about any combination with romantic doom metal or something like that. It's more like late BOLT THROWER for best example. Speaking frankly there are too less faster and more dynamic fragments and I personally miss something like that on the album. Naturally all the "Pain offerings" is made on decent, let's say "professional" level and actually it couldn't be different with such line up.
